

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Does Four County Career Center provide breakfast and lunch?

"YES", Four County Career Center offers a full breakfast and lunch meal. Both meals meet the federal guidelines for type "A" meals and include milk.

How much is the school breakfast and/or lunch?

- Breakfast- \$2.25
- Lunch- \$3.25 (Super Lunch \$3.75)
- Extra milk- \$.60

How do I pay for my student's lunch?

There are no cash payments allowed. You can pay on-line at <u>www.payschoolscentral.com</u> or you can drop a check in the drop box in the cafeteria before school.

I have an on-line lunch account at my child's homeschool. Do I need to create an account at Four County Career Center?

YES, you will need to create a new on-line lunch account at Four County. To do this go to www.payschoolscentral.com then follow the on screen prompts to set up an account.

Do I need to fill out a free and reduced lunch form?

If you are not direct certified, you will need to complete the application. If you are not sure, please fill out the application just in case. *Also we do not get a copy of the free and reduced lunch approval from your associate school.*

If I am direct certified, do I need to fill out the waiver form?

YES... it is very important that you fill out the waiver and return to the main office. The waiver form is located on the last page of the free and reduced lunch form.

- Please refer to your child's cost sheet to determine what fees can be waived.
- The technology fee will be waived accordingly: free lunch- no fee, reduced lunch-\$40 per year (\$20 per semester)

If my high school's first day is after Four County's first day, how will I get to Four County?

Your associate high school will provide a bus for you to come to Four County. Contact your associate school for transportation questions.

Is a technology device provided for each student who attends Four County?

Students have the option to bring their own device. However, a device will be provided if your child does not have one. Technology fees will then be assessed for the use of a technology device-\$40 per semester.

Do I follow Four County's calendar or my child's associate high school?

You will follow Four County's calendar (copy in packet) unless your associate high school is cancelled or delayed because of weather. At that point, you will follow your associate high school delay or cancellation. If they have a delay, you will come to Four County at the delay time (2 hour delay, arrive at Four County 10:45). If your associate high school is cancelled, you will not have to report to Four County on that day.

What is the Four County Attendance Policy?

The Attendance Policy is included in the Student Handbook, they will be handed out the first day of school.
