Are you familiar with the “October Catch?” In the world of Positive Behavioral Interventions &

Supports (PBIS), the “October Catch” is a screening measure and strong predictor in determining students who have the greatest chance of having six or more Office Discipline Referrals (ODRs) by the end of the current school year. Research indicates that early identification of additional interventions and supports for Tier 2 and Tier 3 can help change the trajectory of a student’s behavior, which increases the likelihood that the student’s behavior will improve throughout the course of the school year. This data can also assist your PBIS Leadership Team with looking at the whole picture of your school including identifying possible patterns and trends within your PBIS implementation. When your PBIS Leadership Team meets in November, make sure you review your ODR data from the current school year and identify any students who already have two or more ODRs for the 2022-2023 school year for consideration of Tier 2 or Tier 3 interventions and supports.

## Update on Writing Service Minutes in IEPs from Bernadette Laughlin, Esq.

The Supports & Monitoring Team at the Office for Exceptional Children has reversed its stance and is now stating that writing service minutes as “monthly” is compliant. This is in response to requests from related service providers for flexibility. IEP Teams should discuss in the IEP Team meeting how the services will generally be provided. For example, 160 minutes of service will generally be provided in two 20-minute sessions to be delivered weekly. Then in the follow-up PR-01, state that service delivery was discussed with the team, including parents, in the IEP Team Meeting.
