

Responsibility of Bus Drivers

- 1. The bus driver shall be in charge of the bus at all times and shall be responsible for order. (O.R.C. 3319.41)
- 2. The bus driver shall establish rules necessary for order and the safety of all students.
- 3. The bus driver shall report the unmanageable student to the principal and/or transportation supervisor.
- 4. The bus driver shall assign seats and require that students remain in the assigned seat until the bus arrives at the students' stop.
- 5. The driver has the authority to immediately remove a student from the bus when the students' presence poses a danger to persons or property or a threat to the safe operation of the school bus (ORC 3313.66). The child's welfare must be protected during the immediate removal process.
- 6. Bus drivers shall strive to be punctual during "pick up" and "drop off" times within plus minus five minutes.
- 7. Drivers shall stop at each stop and not start again until students are seated.
