Students will be creating a shoebox diorama for this book project. It is important that the students do the work on this project with some support from adults. Please don't feel like you need to buy anything - be creative and use the items you have at home. The more creative the better!  $\bigcirc$  The project is due by Friday, May 15th, 2020.

Choose your **favorite book** you have read or listened to this year as a fourth grader. It can be a book you have at home, one of our read aloud books, a book we read together in class, a guided reading group book, a library book ... Choose a book that you can talk about.

Your project will have 2 parts: 1) Report and 2) Shoebox Diorama.

Include in your report:	Include in your diorama:
□ <b>Title, Author, Genre, Summary of the Book</b> The summary includes the main characters, setting, problem & solution, important details/events in proper sequence (order). This should be 1-2 paragraphs only. Genre means is it realistic fiction, historical fiction, fantasy, etc.	Re-create the setting of the book you choose. This is your backdrop for the characters.
□ <b>Judgement Paragraph</b> This should be 3-4 sentences on how you rate the book and why. (Why did you enjoy this book? Why do you recommend others read it?) I do <i>not</i> want to see "I liked it. It was good. It was funny." as the three sentences.	<ul> <li>Re-create an important scene or event from the book you choose. Include the characters.</li> <li>*On the examples page, in box two, the diorama shows Fudge</li> </ul>
	trying to "fly like a birdie off of the jungle jim at the park."
