In addition to what our district has sent the Third Grade Team would like to recommend the following ideas for at home instruction. Please remember this is a sensitive time for all so be flexible but still provide a simple routine each and every day. This will help when we are back in session.

For Reading:

- Have your child read each day!
- Talk about the reading.
- Write about it too!
- Read with your child or read to your child.
- If able, please get on LEXIA and have your child work independently on this. 15-25 minutes a day will help meet weekly requirements.
- I have also included a StoryWorks Magazine for your child's reading enjoyment!

For Math:

- Practice math facts by playing games or flashcards.
- Have your child help you in the kitchen with measuring and other math concepts!
- Talk about and review real life math situations with money and time. Have your child sort and count your money.
- Play some games like Monopoly, Checkers, Chess, or Clue. All of these incorporate math and thinking skills.
- If able, please get on IXL and have your child work on the recommended lessons. 15-25 minutes a day will help meet weekly requirements. Please check Remind for lesson updates.
