## Week Seven Science Focus: What is Your Favorite Animal? and a Virtual Zoo Visit

This week you will get to do an independent research project on an animal of your choice. This gives you some control over what you study and lets you research an animal that interests you. We will start our week out with a read aloud. I will post a video of a read aloud of one of my favorite animal books, <a href="Animals Nobody Loves">Animals Nobody Loves</a> by Seymour Simon. After watching the video, you will have a chance to vote on which of the creatures in the book was your favorite. Then it is off on a virtual field trip to the San Diego Zoo. Finally, you will learn about a Zoo Chef who works at our very own Columbus Zoo. Your science

project for the week is to pick an animal of your choice and to create a Google Slide Show. For the week you will have three assignments. These can be found on Google Classroom. They will all four be posted on Monday and you can work on them all week.

- 1) Take a virtual visit to the San Diego Zoo. You should visit at least 3 exhibits.
- 2) Research your favorite animal online. You can search on EPIC for books about the animal of your choice. We also have free access to the website <a href="https://www.facts4me.com">www.facts4me.com</a> which has articles on different types of animals. The log-in information is **username: learn** and **password: read**. The "Facts4Me" link is on my Tizmos page. Then create a Google Slide show on your favorite animal. I have sent you a slide show, but you can change it any way that you want. Share facts about your animal.
- 3) Follow the link to the article about the Zoo Chef. There is even a video with the article that you can watch. After reading the article, you will need to answer the question about the "Coolest Zoo Job" and turn it in to me.

Don't forget to keep working on your Acts of Kindness around the house and for your family. I have gotten a couple of letters from some of you and it has really made me smile! If you do an Act of Kindness, share it with me. If you haven't used your e-mail, it is an easy way to share things with me. You all have your own e-mail and you can find it in your apps.
