Play outside for 30 minutes.	Measure 10 items around your house or yard.	Play a board game or card game with your family.	Make a list of 10 or more ways you can help our Earth	Read a book and write a summary about the book.

Make a list of the top 5 activities you would like to do when the stay-at-home order is over.	See how many doubles facts can you create and solve in 10 minutes.	Design your dream classroom.	Record how many times you and the members of your family wash their hands.
