Math: Find the value of your family's names. Each vowel letter is worth 10 cents, each consonant is 5 cents, and capital letters are 25 cents. Write out each family member's name (I know you all are wondering... yes, you may include pets☺). Find the value of each name.

Example:

Julie= $25+10+5+10+10= 60$ cents

You may use real coins to help you.

****For a challenge, find the total value of everyone's name in your family!**

Writing: Think of a place in the world that you'd like to visit... anywhere! (We know this is imagination because none of us would want to travel the world right now☺) Draw a picture of that place and write 5-7 sentences about that place. Why do you want to go there? What would you do? Who would you want to go with you? Describe the place.
