First Grade-Week 4 Lessons-April 6-10th

Reading and Writing:

*Students need to read at least 10 minutes daily. This can be a book of choice from home, books from online sources, poetry notebooks, or a short story from a children's magazine (such as *Highlights for Children*), etc. This will maintain their fluency and expression in reading.

*Choose at least two stories to read for the week and respond in your writing journal by selecting one of the responses attached to this paper.

*If you do not have a book, enclosed are reading resources you may use for responses.

*We will have a **Zoom** session for reading, which will include a response to reading. If you are not able to log into Zoom, I will contact you to set up an alternate plan.

Math:

In your math workbook, continue as follows:

Monday, April 6 - Complete lesson 9.1, pages 320,321

<u>Tuesday, April 7</u> – Complete lesson 9.2, pages 322, 323, 324, 325 – I will plan to **Zoom** on this day so that we can do the lesson together and go over other concepts in this module.

Wednesday, April 8 – Complete lesson 9.3, pages 326, 327

Thursday, April 9 – Complete lesson 9.4, pages 328, 329, 331

Friday, April 10 and April 13 - No School - Easter/Spring Break

Along with doing **Lexia**, don't forget about the **Lexia** Reading Skills Home Activities on the Washington website, which includes some great reading activities. The **optional Week 3 Letter** includes some great activities incorporating all subject areas with physical activity. All of these resources can be found on the Washington Elementary website under **Staff Pages** (Mrs. Serra). Again, scholastic.com, abcmouse, and infOhio (BookFlix) offer free book resources of stories that students may read online.
