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### Math

Please complete the following 3 math assignments for this week:

- Math Book Lesson 11.4 ~ Multiplication: Solving word problems involving two-digit numbers - pages 404-407
  - \*Read these problems carefully. Some of them are multistep problems.

Once you are in EPIC, search "Loch Ness Monster" and several books and videos will come up. Feel free to use evidence from those resources to strengthen your argument. Next, you will be writing an opinion piece to discuss if you believe the Loch Ness Monster is real or not. Remember, as you write to use the OREO method.

O-Opinion-state your opinion first

R-Reasons--provide reasons you believe this



E-Evidence-provide evidence from texts, videos, etc. to support your reasoning

O-Opinion-conclude with your opinion

This writing can be done in a google doc and submitted for Week 7 on google classroom or it can be done in a regular paper notebook to be handed in later.



### Science for Week 7

We will be studying physical and chemical changes in matter. In a chemical change, a new substance is made, like when you burn a candle.
