### **New Superintendent at Pike-Delta-York**

**Delta, Ohio** – July 19, 2023: The Pike-Delta-York Local School District Board of Education hired Mr. Jonathan Burke to be the District’s next Superintendent at the July board meeting.

Mr. Burke comes to Pike-Delta-York from St Marys Memorial High School where he served as the high school principal for five years. He previously served as the Assistant Principal at St. Marys Middle School for four years. He holds a Bachelor’s Degree from Xavier University (2009), two Master Degrees; a Master of Science in Math Education from Kaplan University (2011), and a Master of Arts in School Leadership from Concordia University Chicago (2015). He is completing his Superintendent Licensure Program with =Concordia University Chicago.

When asked what drew him to Delta, Mr. Burke replied, “PDY has a great reputation around northwest Ohio for being a top-tier school district with high-quality staff. My wife has family in the area so we're familiar with Fulton County. I'm blessed to have the opportunity to work with such great people.” Burke goes on to say, “I'm most excited about meeting our students and sharing the great things they do. I'm looking forward to working with our principals and teachers to see how we can continue improving a high-performing school district. I know this community is passionate about their school. I'm excited to work with our community to provide resources and opportunities for our students.”
