

We operate one of the top Chow Chow breeding kennels in America. We have been breeding Chows for the past 24 years and are recognized nationally. Our farthest Chow placed, resides in Cairo, Egypt and belongs to the daughter of the Saudi Arabian ambassador to Egypt. We have placed puppies in every state in CONUS and every province in Canada.

Weekly Outside Dog Runs - This job description entails the weekly feeding, watering, mowing and cleaning of 10 outside dog runs. In each large shaded run there is an 8'x8'x8' dog shelter enclosing 3 dog houses, a 16 gallon heated water bucket and a 50 pound dry kibble feeder. The runs must be mowed in summer months and poop, twigs & debris emptied into a mobile trash container. The water buckets and feeders must be filled. It is a crucial responsibility to ensure all gates are properly secured to ensure the safety of our dogs. The dry dog food comes in 44 lb. bags and are stored in our kennel feed room. An extension water hose is used to fill each water bucket. We are flexible as to which particular day this job is completed, but once a day is agreed to, we prefer it done weekly so there is a lapse of a 7-day period. This weekly chore typically takes approximately 4 hours to complete, with summer months taking longer due to the need to mow grass, etc.

Weekly Inside Kennel - This entails the weekly general cleaning of our indoor heated kennel, which includes six (6) indoor kennels, a entry room and a wash room. This is mainly accomplished using an indoor electric jet sprayer. This weekly chore typically also takes approximately 4 hours to complete. Due to the risk of viruses and parasites, which might be transmittable, this is vitally important as a preventive measure to assure the health & hygiene of our puppies.

We pay **\$12** per hour, so if the same person performed both weekly chores, they should easily earn about \$100 for the day. The opportunity is there for more hours if wanted.

In addition, we have donkeys, cattle, goats, KuneKune pigs and various poultry, to include chickens, peacocks, turkeys, geese, ducks and guineas. If the employee wanted, we routinely have other opportunities to gain hours; e.g. grooming adult Chows & Bernese Mountain Dogs and many other tasks common to a working mini-farm. We have a Bobcat, tractors, utility vehicle and all landscaping equipment, to include chain saws, blowers, etc. We have a shop with all necessary tools required for maintaining our farm & equipment. We purchase hay & straw, which must be stacked in our barn. Our chicken coop must be cleaned in the spring, run-in sheds cleaned and wood split. We maintain bee hives and have a

garden & raised beds. We have an inground pool available for our employees after work.
