- 2. Molly has DAC information: Presented slides about Digital Citizenship curriculum being done by Mr. Evans at CMS. There are 6 modules and they are geared towards the grade levels K-12 with revisiting of things learned previously with lesson plans, videos, parent resource sites. The DAC wants to share/spread through the district. Dana will send the link for this out.
- 3. Spoke about #5 on agenda (school bond survey). Molly and Lane spoke about how it seems to only benefit ECC and the high school & charters. Group decided to shelve until next time after the school board meeting this evening.
- 4. Discussed #6 TLA model Dana said that JES is looking at it as a whole school model and OGES might be interested in this model for 1 grade level only at this time. Discussed staffing and what it looks like and why. She said that this was a way to help people complete/seek degrees through the ARL program and be able to get paid while learning and to help attract student teachers. Dana then showed slides with the TLA model and explained job descriptions:

  Lead teacher (over 5 years teaching)- in charge of it all data, planning, work, etc.
