Athens AMVETS Post 76 will be awarding a \$2000.00, a \$1,000.00, and a \$500.00 scholarship or financial aid for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place to Athens County High School seniors based on the following criteria:

1. Academic achievement
2. Candidate must be the **son, daughter, step-son, step-daughter, or grandchild of a Veteran.**
3. Candidate's academic qualifications must be certified by an authorized representative (preferably principal or guidance counselor) of the candidate's high school; that representative must also sign the application form.
4. Candidate must submit a one page, preferably typed essay regarding his/her ambitions and goals.
5. Candidate must submit a list of all outside activities such as clubs, sports, band, community service involvement (volunteer work).

The scholarship or financial aid funds will be sent directly to the college or university of choice.

Judging will be done by a 5 member committee who score the criteria individually. These scores are then consolidated to arrive at the top three places.
