

SUBJECT: SUPERINTENDENT PANDEMIC AUTHORITY

Recognizing the ever changing nature of CDC and NYSDOH regulations during times of pandemic the Madrid-Waddington Central School Board does authorize the Superintendent of Schools to design, initiate and enforce quarantine, isolation, test to stay, and any other programmatic protocols necessary to maintain school operations, ensure student and staff safety, and maximize student access to all academic and extracurricular offerings.

This policy shall act to serve as authorization with regards to all pandemic related regulations that require a specific Board policy.

The Superintendent shall consult with pertinent district level teams, public health departments, and school health officials while making decisions in this capacity. The Superintendent shall ensure that all protocols and procedures are aligned with current regulations to the extent practicable.
