SUBJECT: VETERANS

A veteran of any age who has been discharged under conditions other than dishonorable from an armed force of the United States may attend any public school (Section 3202 Education Law, Subdivision 1, Laws of 1976). When veterans enroll as students in or through the Madrid Waddington Central School District they will not be charged tuition if they are under twenty-one (21) and have not received a high school diploma. However, if they are over twenty-one (21) and have not received a high school diploma, they will be charged tuition based on the following method of calculation.

- a) High school programs at Madrid Waddington Central cost per student, as computed by the Business Manager, minus allowable state aid. The rest becomes a charge to the veteran and will be billed in two equal installments (October and February) and must be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the bill or the student may be dropped.
- b) Programs at BOCES will be computed in the following method. BOCES tuition less our state aid leaves the amount to be paid by the veteran. This amount will be billed in two (2) equal installments (October and February) and must be paid within thirty days (30) of the date of the bill or the student may be dropped.
- c) Attendance of veterans will be reported to the high school principal by BOCES. Poor attendance may result in the veteran being discontinued in this program. Also, lack of satisfactory achievement may result in denying the veteran's right to attend this program.
- d) Veterans must follow the same rules and regulations as other students.
