MINIMUM COURSE REQUIREMENT AND COURSE INFORMATION

Four weeks before the courses, the director will look through course enrollment to make sure there's a minimum number of students signed up for the class. If the courses do not meet the minimum requirement of students, it will be cancelled. At that time, the parent can choose to sign up their child for another class. Students may be signed up for one, two or all three hours each week. Faculty will be transporting the students to their next enrichment class.
