Legislative Report - Mrs. Mayfield provided that the State Board of Education elected a new president, Charlotte McGuire, and vice president Steve Dackin.; Governor DeWine signed Senate Bill 258 which addresses the Congressional Redistricting map for the next four years (Mrs. Mayfield mentioned this may be contested); Senate Ways and Means Committee met and discussed HB 126. If passed this bill will require school districts to pass a resolution each time a property valuation is challenged. The school board will be required to send a written notice to the property owner indicating their intent to challenge it.
