

Immunization Requirements

Below is a list of the **required** immunization students must have to meet the requirements for school attendance in the State of Ohio. There are also immunizations that are not required for school attendance but are **recommended** by several major medical organizations. These immunizations are also listed below.

ALL students must have a complete vaccination record on file at school within 15 days of attendance. If you have any questions regarding the requirements or your child's immunization record please contact your child's school nurse.

Vaccine	Requirement	
DTaP/DTP/Tdap/Td	Kindergarten	
Diptheria, tetanus,	5 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT, or any combination, if the	
pertusis	fourth dose was administered prior to the 4th birthday	
pertusis	Grades 1-12	
	3-4 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT or Td or any combination.	
	Grades 7-12	
	1 dose of Tdap or Td vaccine must be administered prior to	
	entry.	
Polio	K-6	
	A minimum of 3 doses. The final dose must have been given on	
	or after the 4th birthday, regardless of the number of previous	
	doses; 4 doses if a combination of OPV and IPV was	
	administered.	
	Grades 7-12	
	4 doses if a combination of OPV and IPV was administered.	
	4 doses of all OPV or all IPV is required if the third dose of either	
	vaccine was administered prior to the 4th birthday.	
MMR	K-12	
Measles, mumps,	2 doses of MMR. Dose 1 must be administered on or after the first	
rubella	birthday. The second dose must be administered at least	
	28 days after dose 1.	
Hep B	K-12	
Hepatitis B	3 doses of Hepatitis B. The second dose must be administered at	
	least 28 days after the first dose. The third dose must be given at	
	least 16 weeks after the first dose and at least 8 weeks after the	
	second dose. The last dose in the series (third or fourth dose), must not be administered before age 24 weeks.	
X 7	K-6	
Varicella	2 doses of varicella vaccine must be administered prior to entry.	
Chicken Pox	Grade 7-10	
	1 dose of varicella vaccine must be administered on or after the	
	first birthday.	
Meningococcal	Grade 7	
_	1 dose of meningococcal (serogroups A,C, W, and Y) vaccine must	
(MCV4)	be administered prior to entry.	
	Grade 12	
	2 doses of meningococcal (serogroups A, C, W, and Y) vaccine must	
	be administered prior to entry.

RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATIONS

(Not required for school but recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics, the American Academy of Family Physicians, and the CDC)

Vaccine	Requirement
Influenza	Recommended annually for all persons> 6 months of
TT	age.
Human	This is a series of 3 vaccines begun at age 11-12 years.
Papillomairus	
(HPV)	This immunization protects against Human
	Papillomavirus which is the leading cause of cervical
	cancer in women and genital warts in men and women.
	The vaccine is only given until age 18.
