We know that students benefit from in-person learning. Our goal is to keep students back in school, in-person five days a week.

	Grades K-6	Grades 7-12
Masking	<ul> <li>Students: Students will be required to wear a mask inside the school and when on any school transportation. Masks are optional when eating lunch or outside for recess or outdoor activities.</li> <li>Staff: Masks are strongly recommended for all vaccinated and unvaccinated staff while indoors. Please mask in common areas (outside your classroom)</li> </ul>	Masks are strongly recommended for all vaccinated and unvaccinated students and staff while indoors. Masks are <b>required</b> when riding on any school transportation.
Social Distancing	Whenever possible, there should be 3 feet between students in the classroom and when in larger groups.	Same as Elementary School
Breakfast, Lunch & Recess	Elementary schools will continue with last year's breakfast, lunch and recess protocols which keeps students in smaller cohorts.	Students in grades 7-12 will continue with last year's lunch schedule to maximize physical distance as much as possible in eating areas.
Handwashing	Washing hands more often during the day is encouraged and providing hand sanitizing stations in all learning areas will continue.	Same as Elementary School
Ventilation	When possible windows will be kept open to allow for fresh air to circulate. Fans can be used and outdoor activities are encouraged.	Same as Elementary School
Cleaning Protocols	Extended cleaning of all classroom surfaces and learning areas will continue.	Same as Elementary School
Visitors & Volunteers	Nonessential visitors and volunteers are not approved at this time.	Same as Elementary School

This plan was created by analyzing the district and regional vaccination rate data as well as reviewing guidance from local, state, federal health departments and organizations.

It will be modified as needed based on the continued review of ongoing vaccination rate data, input from parents and staff and guidance from local, state, federal health departments and organizations.
