 - Students A-K attend in person Monday and Tuesday – Remote learning Wed., Thurs., Fri.
 - Students L –Z attend in-person Thursday and Friday – Remote learning Mon., Tues., Wed.
- <u>Authorization for Superintendent to Declare Remote</u>

• The Board of Education has given Dr. Anstadt permission to declare remote learning in the event the Toledo-Lucas Co. Health Department's data suggests remote learning is the best method due to rising COVID-19 cases in Lucas County.
