3. Purchases over \$25,000

Washington Local Schools Policy 6320—Purchases Limitations

All purchases (purchase order/contract) except utilities and emergency purchases, that are within the amount contained in the appropriation and were originally contemplated in the budgeting process may be made upon authorization of the Treasurer unless the contemplated purchase is for more than \$25,000, in which case prior approval is required from the Board of Education.

The Treasurer is authorized to adjust appropriations within a fund in order to make necessary purchases and shall report such modifications at the following regular Board meeting.

The Treasurer is authorized to make emergency purchases, without prior adjustment, or Board approval of those goods and/or services needed to keep the schools in operation. Emergency purchases that exceed \$25,000 will be submitted for approval at the next Board meeting.

Executive Summary

The Washington Local Schools Wi-Fi network will be seven years old in July of 2020. The access points do need to be replaced/updated as they age and as the technology changes. We are working through the process of applying for eRate reimbursement. We are estimating that the rebate on this purchase should be around \$16,695. The final cost to WLS should be around \$11,130 for 75 enterprise Wi-Fi access points. Based on the price quotes received I would recommend that we purchase 75 access points from CDWG for \$27,825.00.

Details

The Washington Local Schools WiFi network is currently using 330 Access Points to provide coverage for all wireless devices. The AP models beginning with a Z are now seven years old. We have been steadily replacing APs and adding new ones to increase capacity over the last three years. With this purchase we will be able to replace 75 of the old units. The plan is to

purchase another 70 in SY21-22 to complete the refresh. We will then continue to replace 70 units a year to help ensure that the access points will be able to handle the demands. These access points can also be moved anywhere in the district and can be moved from an old building into a new building.

We submitted a request for quote through the eRate process so that we could recover as much of the hardware costs as possible. Four vendors responded to the eRate posting. A summary of those responses is included below:

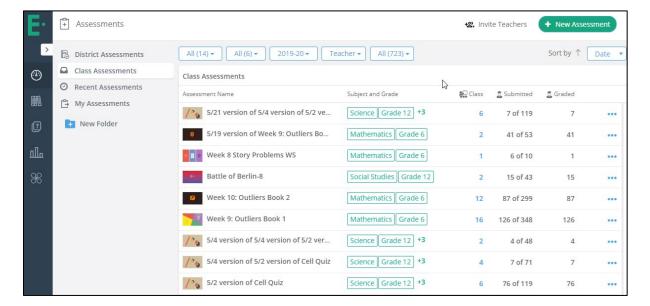

Executive Summary

This purchase is for replacement desktop Windows computers, computer monitors, and digital projectors.

The district continues to need to maintain Windows desktop computers for offices and teacher computers connected to SmartBoards in the classroom. We have been able to standardize on a seven-year life-span for most standard desktop computers. This order will replace 100 standard desktop units.

Computer monitors do have a longer life-span than the desktop computers. However, they do still have problems over time and there has been a steady migration away from the classic VGA ports being available on the desktop computers. These replacement monitors come with DisplayPort, HDMI, and the classic VGA ports all built into the monitor itself. This helps make the monitors a universal fit with our current desktop collection without needing to purchase adapter devices. This order will replace 100 desktop monitors.

Digital projectors also require replacement. After 8+ years even with bulb-less projectors (they use laser emitters) the lenses tend to discolor and the image begins to dim. 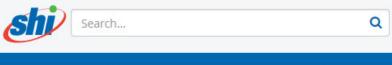

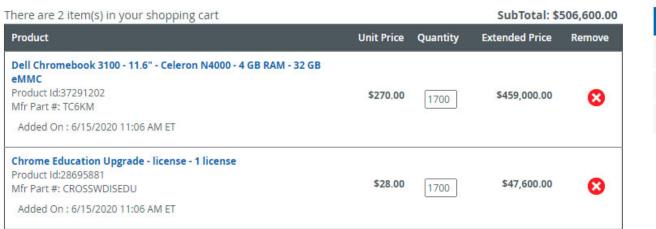

Executive Summary

Washington Local Schools contracts for both special education *programs* and *purchased services* through Lake Erie West Educational Services Center for our students with disabilities. This request for board approval includes contracts for two school years. One benefit of agreeing to a two-year contract is that LEW is agreeing to maintain all costs at the same rates for both years. Further, Lake Erie West has not increased per student program costs for ALC or Preschool nor have the hourly rates for related services increased from the 2018-2020 contract rates.

Increases for the 2020-2021 school year compared to the 2019-2020 school year are due to:

- 1.) increases in the students accessing programing at both the ALC and more significantly, preschool, and
- 2.) the purchase of additional services to support student literacy learning.

Program Services and Costs

Programs have a per-student charge. A base enrollment is assigned to estimate costs. At the end of the school year, accounts are reconciled. Our enrollments have increased at both the ALC and in our preschool programming. The demand for preschool programming has increased by 10 to 15 students per year over the past two to three years.

Alternate Learning Center (ALC)

The ALC is a separate facility educational program for K-12 students with severe learning, behavioral, and mental health needs. The program is housed at the Washington Local Westwood Building. Billing is based on daily attendance with the per-student cost calculated on 181 student days. Thus, there may be more than 28 WLS students (the base enrollment for this contract) enrolled over the course of the year, though not each student will attend a full 181 days.

Other surrounding districts place students at the ALC including Ottawa Hills, Perrysburg, Sylvania, Anthony Wayne, Rossford, and Maumee. Washington Local is the primary consumer of this service. Approximately 65% of the students attending the ALC are WLS students.

Per student cost for the ALC include:

- One classroom aide.
- School psychologist, counselor, behavior consultant, and nurse services as well as a resource office.
- The ALC program meets all state curriculum and graduation requirements and includes art, PE, and music instruction.
- Per student cost does not include other related services such as speech therapy, OT, APE, or additional aide services, which are billed separately per student need.

Preschool Program

The LEW preschool program is located in the Washington Local Westwood Building. The program is an "integrated preschool" and participates in a grant which requires maintaining an approximate ratio of half of the students having disabilities and half of the students not having disabilities. This provides both groups of students with peer models to learn from and with.

We currently have five (5) preschool programs all of which are located at the WLS Westwood Building. Each teacher has an a.m. and p.m. section and can have up to eight students with disabilities and eight students without an IEP in a class. The total capacity of the program classrooms is 160 students. Total capacity for students with disabilities in the preschool program is 80 students. We are billed for students with disabilities only. The students without disabilities pay tuition to attend based on a sliding fee scale. Our preschool classrooms are shared with Ottawa Hills who currently has 4 students enrolled in the program.

For the past two years we have *ended the year* with approximately 85 preschool students on IEPs. Additional students in excess of the capacity of 80 are served using itinerate services in their homes until a vacancy is available in one of the classrooms. Each spring, approximately half of the students on IEPs transition to kindergarten creating available space for new students.

Per student cost for the Preschool Program include:

- One aide per classroom.
- Related Services: Audiology, OT, PT, Speech, and School Psychologist services.
- Services for a Teacher for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing and Teacher for the Visually Impaired are billed separately based on student need for these services.

PROGRAM COST AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into between the Washington Local School District and the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West for the 2020-21 school year.

In consideration of the promises and terms contained herein and pursuant to all relevant sections of the Ohio Revised Code, the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West agrees to provide the following services and personnel:

- Classroom instruction at the Alternate Learning Center-West Campus at an enrollment base of twenty-eight (28) students - see Attachment A
- Gifted Program Services of 3.733 FTE Gifted Teachers
- Gifted Program Services of .8 FTE Universal Design for Learning Coach
- Preschool Services at an enrollment base of seventy (70) special needs students see Attachment A
- Preschool-Autism Scholarship Students at an enrollment base of two (2) students
- School Psychologist K-12 1.0 FTE
- Speech Language Pathologist 1.0 FTE
- Occupational Therapist 1.0 FTE
- At Large School Improvement Consultants
- Literacy Consultant Services .2 FTE
- Consulting Services (74 days)
- Literacy Coach 1.0 FTE

It is agreed that the Washington Local School District will compensate the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West an annual amount as indicated on the attached Program Cost Calculation for the 2020-21 school year. Contracted Services not included in the programs will be invoiced monthly based on the rates listed on Attachment A. Additional Services are listed on Attachment A.

It is further agreed that the Washington Local School District will compensate the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West for student enrollment exceeding the base enrollment at an annual cost per student as listed on Attachment A. Should student enrollment of the district decline in the program(s), the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West will reimburse the district for the program cost overcharge derived from student enrollment. The Washington Local School District will be responsible for submitting written documentation to the Program Administrator of the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West in the event a student is withdrawn from the program. Monthly invoices will continue until proper documentation for withdrawal is received from the Washington Local School District. The Superintendent of the Educational Service Center reserves the right to determine the staffing assignments for the service to be provided and to assign the necessary personnel to perform the contracted services.

In the event that the Washington Local School District makes the decision to discontinue any of the above listed services, it will be the responsibility of the Washington Local School District to notify the Superintendent of the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West in writing before March 31st of the preceding school year in which the services will be discontinued. If the Washington Local School District fails to make the notification prior to March 31st of the preceding school year, the service will continue to be provided during the next school year and the Washington Local School District will continue to compensate the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West for the services.

The Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West will comply with the requirements of 45 CFR 164.504(e)(1) for safeguarding and limiting access to information concerning beneficiaries and will allow the representatives of the U. S. Department of Human Services, ODJFS, ODE or their respective designee access to the subcontractor's books, documents and records. This agreement acknowledges that the Educational Service Center of Lake Erie West or their principles are not suspended or debarred.

WASHINGTON LOCAL SCHOOLS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between Board of Education and Ohio Association of Public School Employees

REGARDING ONE-TIME RETIREMENT INCENTIVE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made on this 24th day of June, 2020, by and between the Washington Local School District Board of Education, hereinafter "Board," and the Ohio Association of Public School Employees (OAPSE)/AFSCME Local 4/AFL-CIO and Its Local #279, hereinafter "Union," regarding a one-time retirement incentive.

WHEREAS, the Board and OAPSE are parties to a collective bargaining agreement ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to provide for a one-time monetary incentive to bargaining unit members to retire earlier than they might otherwise elect to do, as a means of reducing spending in light of recently- announced state budget cuts;

NOW, THEREFORE, effective immediately upon the signing of this document by the representatives of all parties, the Board and the Union mutually agree that:

- 1. A one-time, lump sum, retirement incentive payment shall be offered to eligible classified employees in the bargaining unit.
- 2. To be eligible for the retirement incentive, employees must:
 - a) be eligible for unreduced service retirement from SERS; and
 - b) provide notice to the Treasurer on or before July 15, 2020, that they intend to resign from all employment with the Board for purposes of retirement between June 30, 2020, and August 31, 2020; and
 - c) have contractually worked in the Washington Local School District for at least five (5) consecutive years and be retiring from active service; and
 - d) sign an agreement and election to retire on a form provided by the Board.

- 3. The amount of the retirement incentive payment will depend on the eligible employee's resignation date. All eligible employees shall receive a payment equal to twenty percent (20%) of the base annual wages they received for the 2019-2020 school year, up to a maximum of Nine-Thousand- Five-Hundred Dollars (\$9,500.00). Base wages shall exclude overtime pay, extra trip pay, or any other supplemental or bonus pay.
- 4. The retirement incentive payment described in this MOU shall be in addition to the any Retirement Pay to which the bargaining unit member may be entitled under Article 14, Section E, of the Agreement. The retirement incentive payment described in this MOU shall be payable in a lump sum within 45 days following the bargaining unit member's resignation date.
- 5. An employee who receives a retirement incentive payment under this MOU may be employed as a substitute, as long as at least two months have elapsed from the effective date of his/her retirement from an Ohio retirement system.
- 6. The parties agree that the Board may, in its discretion, choose not to fill one or more of the positions vacated by bargaining unit members opting to retire and take the retirement incentive payment under this MOU. Further, the parties agree that the Board may instead, in its discretion, choose to fill such a vacated position with a substitute for one hundred twenty (120) calendar days, notwithstanding anything that may be to the contrary in Article 8 of the Agreement. This provision shall not be construed to alter the requirements of the Agreement for posting and bidding of other vacancies.
- 7. This constitutes the entire agreement between the Board and OAPSE regarding the issues outlined herein. There are no other written or verbal agreements, understandings or arrangements between the parties regarding the issues outlined herein. Any amendment to this MOU must be in writing and signed by both parties.
- 8. OAPSE and the Board have reviewed and understand this MOU and each signatory to this MOU represents that he or she has the authority to enter into this MOU and bind his/her party.
- 9. This MOU shall expire on December 31, 2020 and shall not be construed to set any precedent with respect to interpretation of the Agreement relating to posting, bidding or filling of positions, retirement pay, or otherwise.
