Between the Board of Education and the Teachers' Association

Extension of Retirement Notification Deadline

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic that prompted the Ohio Department of Health to order all Ohio K-12 school buildings closed, beginning March 17, 2020 through to the remainder of the school year, the Washington Local Schools Board of Education and TAWLS agree that the unprecedented pandemic has created a difficult situation for teachers to consider their immediate retirement options.

It is hereby mutually agreed between the Board of Education and TAWLS that:

- In Article 19, Section E, the deadline to give notice of intent to retire at the end of the 2019-2020 school year shall be extended to June 18, 2020 from the original date of February 1, 2020.
- In Article 19, Section E, as a result of the said June 18, 2020 extension for the notice of intent to retire, the deadline also applies to the compensation of sick leave days per the payment formula cited in Article 19, Section C.

The extension of the deadline is for the current year only, and is not precedent setting.
