District to Interview Architects for New PK-12 Building

Logan Elm Local School District, in conjunction with Ohio Facilities Construction Commission, is releasing the shortlist of architect firms to be interviewed for architecture and design services for the new PK-12 school building. Voters approved a bond issue for the construction of the new building in November 2018.

It is anticipated that the firms will be interviewed in mid-December 2019, with selection of a firm announced in late December 2019 or early January 2020. The District expects to begin the visioning and design process in early 2020.

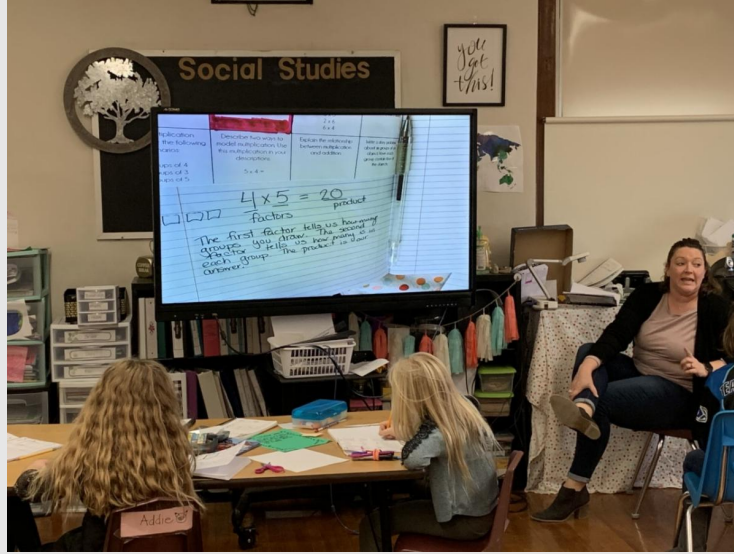
Math and Technology Go Together!
