# **New Building Update**

On August 23, 2019, the construction of the new K-12 Building took a step forward. Board of Education members Scott Allen and Michael Linton, Superintendent Tim Williams, and Mike Mendenhal of Mendenhall MCS, conducted a meeting with Ohio Facilities Construction Commision (OFCC) representatives Valerie Montoya (Planning), Stacey Thomas (Projects), and Rhonda Hagemeyer (Projects). This meeting signals the transition from OFCC's planning phase to the project phase.

As a result of this meeting, the process to create a request for proposal for an architect to design the new building will begin. This process should take approximately four weeks. It is with great excitement that we move into this next phase of providing a modern educational environment for our students.

#### **Stadium Restroom Renovations**

Over the course of the past several years, the Logan Elm Board of Education has made an effort to address the facilities and grounds at the main campus. The improvements began in the 2017-2018 school year with a new waste water system for the high school and middle school. Last summer, the district addressed the aging track and replaced the lights at the athletic complex.

As you attend events this fall, you will notice new fencing on the campus as well as construction taking place to improve the restroom facilities for the athletic complex. These restrooms are located in the Agriculture building at the entrance to Braves Stadium.

Summit Construction is working on the athletic complex restroom project. This renovation includes enlarging and updating the restrooms while improving handicapped accessibility. Construction has begun and the District is hoping that the new restrooms will be completed by late September. Once completed, the restroom renovation project will greatly improve the community's experience while attending events at the athletic complex.
