Students earned awards for perfect attendance, 95% attendance, bus awards and BUG (bringing up grades). Pictured are the fourth grade students who received awards in the various categories.

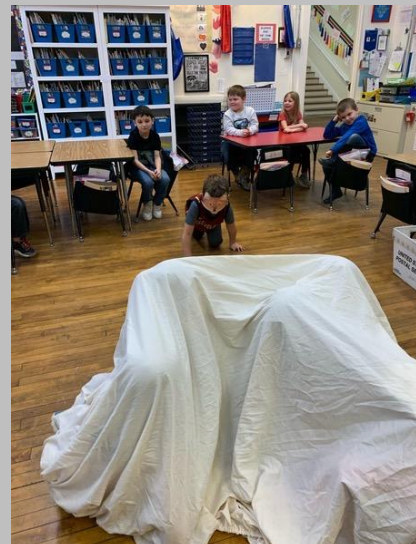


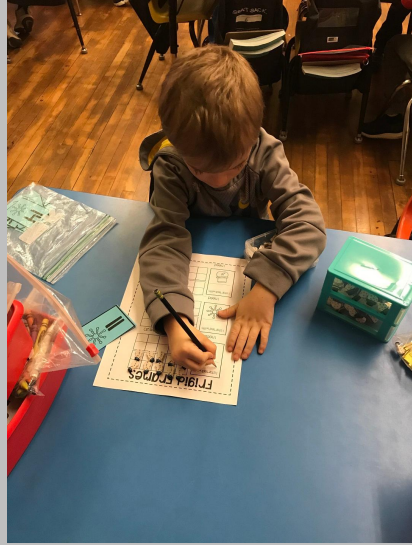
Washington Kindergarten Students Get Creative
