### Logan Elm Switched to "Remote Learning" prior to Thanksgiving

We would like to thank everyone for doing their part to ensure our students can remain in school. We recently completed our 13th week of school, which included seven weeks of students being present daily in all our buildings. We have been able to accomplish this by wearing masks, properly social distancing, practicing good hygiene and cooperating with quarantines, when they arise. We are extremely proud of the efforts of our students and staff!

Logan Elm officials continue to work with our local health departments while monitoring the number of COVID cases, the number of students/staff who are quarantined, as well as other illness. As the number of cases continue to rise, we encourage each of you to continue to follow the guidelines outlined by Federal, State and local agencies to help slow the spread of COVID.

Beginning Monday, November 16th, the District switched to Remote Learning in response to the number of local COVID cases. Students were not present at school on these days, but received instruction via remote learning. This decision allowed our custodians to deep clean the buildings, provided a natural break for our students/staff as cases continued to rise in our community, and allowed students/staff to return from quarantines on December 1, 2020. During this time, we will continue to work with the health department and monitor our local numbers.

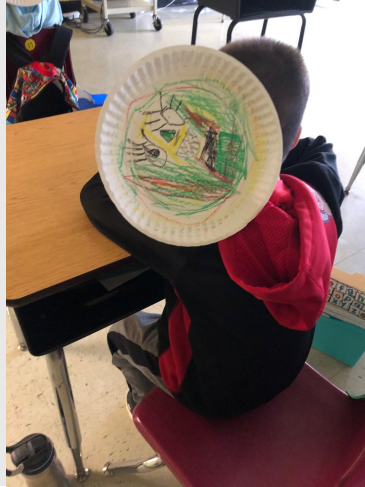
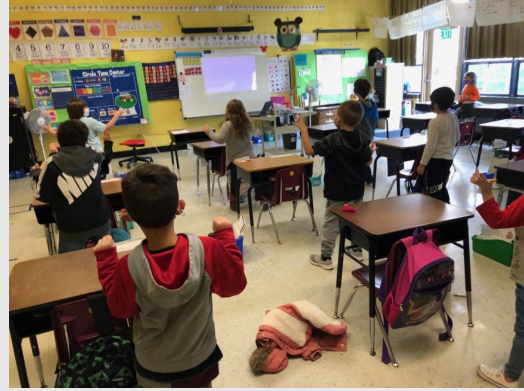

When Logan Elm Schools transitioned to remote learning recently, the Food Service Department quickly organized the distribution of breakfast and lunch meals. Under the direction of Ginger Selin, Food Service Supervisor, a plan was created to have meals ready for pick up on November 18th. Students were able to pick up 5-7 breakfast and lunch meals at either of two locations--McDowell Middle School or Laurelville Elementary.

During the "grab and go" distribution, our Food Service Department gave out nearly 2000 meals to almost 300 students. In conjunction with the USDA, all meals were free to any Logan Elm student. Once in person classes resume, all meals will continue to be free through the end of the 2020-2021 school year.
