To the Logan Elm Community:

Over the course of the past month, COVID-19 numbers have continued to surge in our community. The District continues to make every effort for children to remain in school. By pausing operations prior to Thanksgiving, requiring everyone to wear masks, practicing good hygiene and by increasing social distancing, we are taking the necessary steps to be in school. Unfortunately, the number of local cases continue to affect the number of students and staff who are COVID positive or quarantined.

Logan Elm officials continue to work with our local health departments while monitoring the number of COVID cases, the number of students/staff who are quarantined, as well as other illnesses. As the number of cases continue to rise, I encourage each of you to continue to follow guidelines outlined by Federal, State and local agencies to help slow the spread of COVID. Many health officials have warned of an increase of cases during the holiday season and we are seeing the effects of the surge.

On **Friday, December 11**, the District will transition to on-line learning. Students will receive instruction via remote learning on December 11<sup>th</sup> and the week of December 14<sup>th</sup>. Winter break is scheduled for December 21-January 3. During this time, we will continue to work with the health department and monitor our local numbers. We will make a decision about the future status of school by December 30<sup>th</sup>. All extra-curricular activities will be paused **immediately** and re-evaluated on December 27, 2020.
