SUMMARY/OBJECTIVE OF POSITION

The Preschool Promise Connector will serve as a public face of Preschool Promise on social media. The position will "connect" families with early childhood education opportunities to help young children get ready for kindergarten. The Connector will interact with children, families, teachers, community partners, and the public to help families understand the power of Preschool and the importance of building young children's brains in the early years. The Connector will represent Preschool Promise with energetic enthusiasm and will maintain a positive reputation on and off camera.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

The following duties are representative of performance expectations. A reasonable accommodation may be made to enable a qualified individual with a disability to perform essential functions.

- 1) Represent Preschool Promise as a public face on social media and at events, with a particular focus on families with children under the age of 5
- 2) Create, edit and schedule original content across social media platforms
 - a) TikTok, Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, YouTube



- 3) Work within a team to create social media content
 - a) Curate and schedule content for Preschool Promise social media platforms
 - b) Work with graphic designers to create posts in a timely manner
- 4) Respond appropriately and in a timely manner to comments left by followers on social media channels
- 5) Troubleshoot technical aspects of social media channels
- 6) Work with Preschool Promise team and contractors to build a strong presence with families of young children to increase the enrollment in Preschool programs

FUNDING OF THIS POSITION

Preschool Promise, Inc. funds this position through a legal agreement with the Montgomery County ESC to lease employees to accomplish the Preschool Promise vision and mission. Preschool Promise, Inc. receives core funding from the City of Dayton and Montgomery County



through tax revenues. This position is on the payroll of the Montgomery County Educational Service Center (ESC) and requires an annual contract between August-July – if the position begins at a different time the contract may be shorter term, with the potential to renew.
