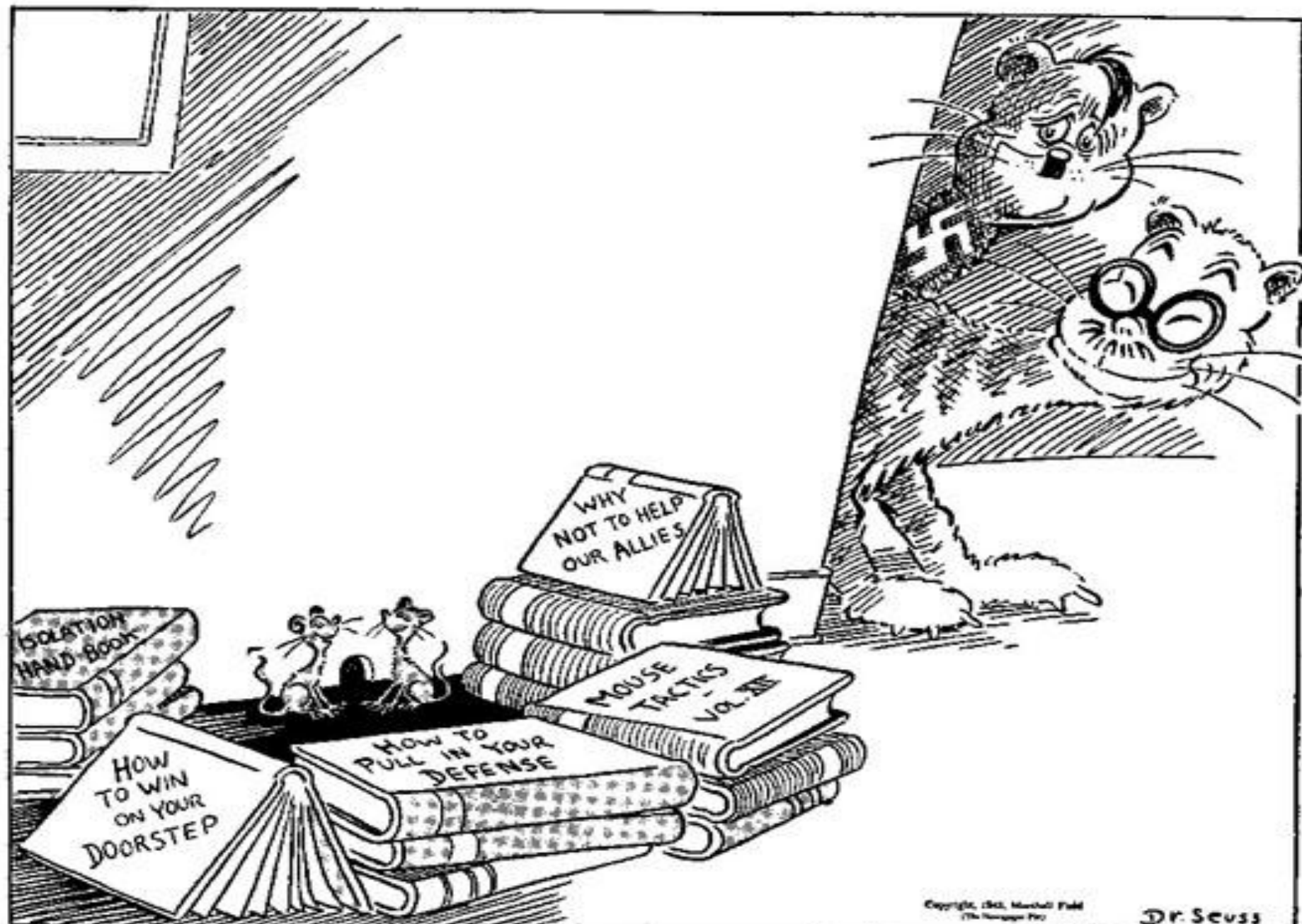
The Isolationist

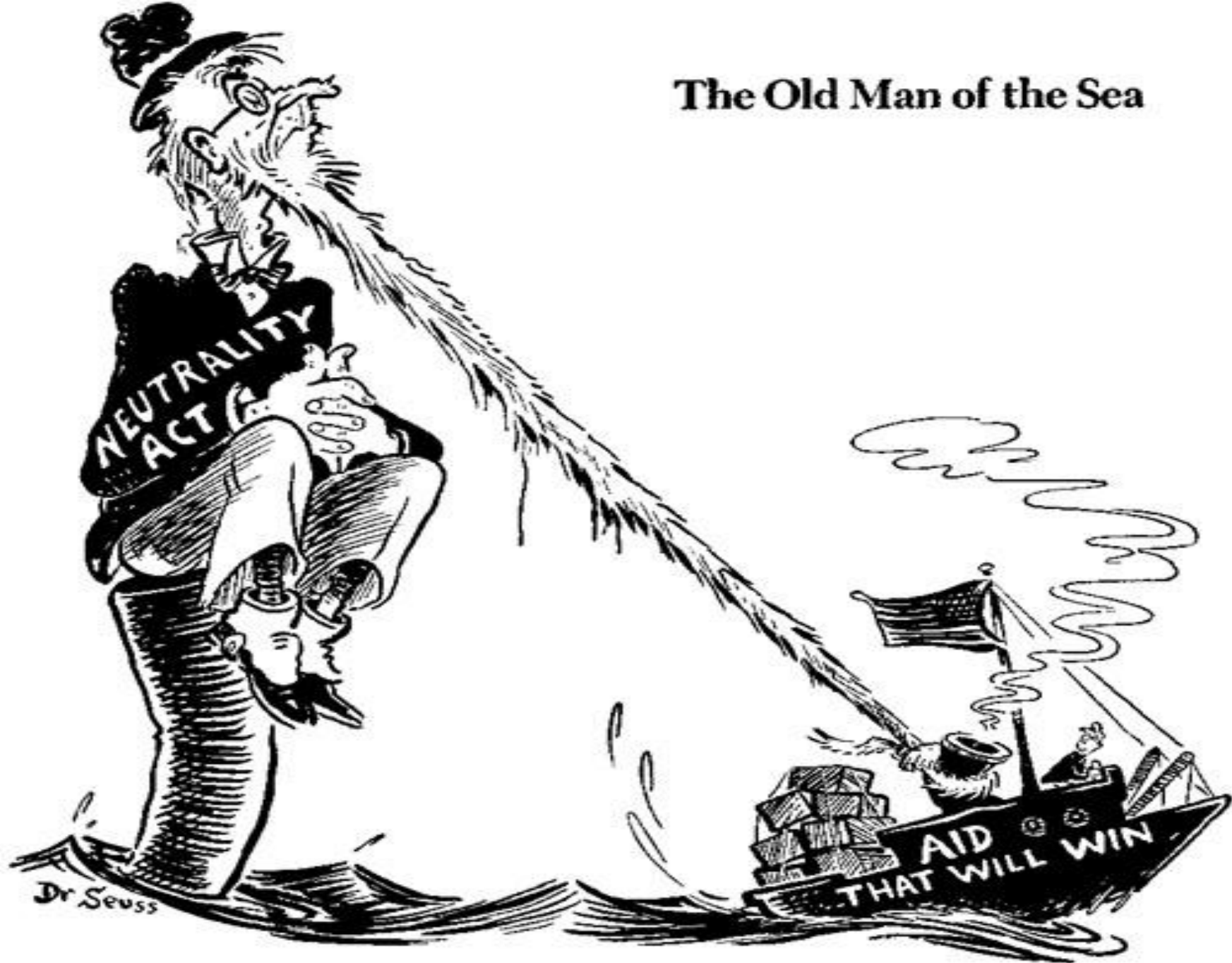
