Now that the PK-12 building is up and running, attention has turned to other updates to the campus.

What was previously the AG building is being renovated into a custom weight room for Logan Elm athletes. The building will also house the LE football team locker room along with additional boy's and girl's locker rooms, trainer's room, AD and coaches' offices.

The Athletic Boosters is making a \$100,000 investment to furnish this building for our student athletes. This project was not part of the bond issue and is funded by the district.









The ground where LEHS once stood is cleared of debris. This will be the home of a practice soccer field and middle school baseball diamond. Middle school softball will also get a new field, which will be placed to the west of the building. These fields are targeted to be ready by 2025.
