The Momentum Award is given to schools and districts that have demonstrated notable progress in their performance while maintaining a trajectory of continued academic growth.

The Momentum Award is granted to schools and districts that have improved their performance index by 3 or more points from the previous year's report card (2022-2023) to the current year (2023-2024), in addition to achieving a value-added progress rating of 4 or more stars.

Only 193 schools in Ohio receive this award, making up less than 7% of all schools in the state. This statistic highlights the impressive growth taking place at Logan Elm Elementary.

Joanna Strawser, Principal at Logan Elm Elementary, was humbled by this recognition, simply stating that we can only thank our teachers for this growth.

"Our teachers meet students where they are. They acknowledge their current situation and emotions without judgement. Our staff makes sure each child can reach their educational potential," said Mrs. Strawser.
