K-5 Literacy Curriculum Framework

Tier 1 Instruction is provided to all students by the classroom teacher with a Structured Literacy approach. The *Reading Horizons* foundational program is used in kindergarten through second grade and the *Wit & Wisdom* comprehensive language arts curriculum is used in kindergarten through fifth grade. Supplemental instruction is provided through the *i-Ready Personalized Learning Path*. Assessments include teacher observation, curriculum assessments, Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA), *i-Ready* Diagnostics and Literacy Tasks, and Ohio State Tests.

Tier 2 Intervention is provided by classroom teachers, reading specialists, or intervention specialists as needed based on assessment data showing below grade level progress. One or more of the following will be provided in addition to Tier 1 instruction.

- Tutoring using Tier 1 materials
- Additional intensity in *i-Ready Personalized Learning* with teacher interventions and *i-Ready* supporting material
- Tutoring utilizes a multi-modal approach to structured literacy, either through the Sonday System curriculum or individualized by a structured literacy certified specialist.

Tier 3 Intervention is provided by a reading specialist or intervention specialist when progress is not shown in a reasonable amount of time with Tier 2 intervention. Tutoring with additional intensity utilizes a multi-modal approach to structured literacy, either through the Sonday System curriculum or individualized by a structured literacy certified specialist.
