Northfield Elementary School will host the annual field day events on **Monday, May 24th**, with a rain date scheduled for Wednesday, May 26th. Schedule:

Grades 2, 4 and 1/2 day kindergarten students will attend from 9:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. The 1/2 day kindergarten students will be finished by their normal dismissal time of 11:45 a.m.

Grades 1, 3, and full-time kindergarten students will attend from 12:30 p.m. until 3:30 p.m.

Remote Families:

Any remote student that would like to attend with their grade level are more than welcome to participate; however, <u>remote students must RSVP</u> so that we can create teams and make

Remote students should eat before their scheduled time **or** after their scheduled time offcampus since they will only be here for a half-day. Parents will need to drop-off children utilizing the normal carpool process. Staff will be available to manage arrival and departure.

All students will be maskless during the actual field day games while outside. Masks will need to be worn should a child/staff member re-enter the building to use the restroom.
