RECYCLING CHALLENGE CONCLUDES

Northfield's plastic recycling project has officially come to an end. We are pleased to announce that Northfield Elementary School surpassed its goal of collecting 1,000 pounds. As a school community, we collected 1,100 pounds! That means 1,100 pounds of plastic will not go to landfills or oceans.



Instead, it will be recycled. The plastic that we collected will go to our partners at Trex. The company will turn the plastic into decking material. If your family still has plastic to donate there is a collection bin at Giant Eagle in Northfield. Northfield and Trex are only encouraging you to donate when you feel comfortable doing so. The collection bins are a permanent fixture at Giant Eagle. On April 22, (Earth Day), Trex will announce the winners of the 2019-2020 Plastic Recycling Challenge. Thank you for your contributions!
