Each student bag has a variety of materials that have been prepared for each child; including, student artwork, workbooks, summer reading list, school supply list, PTA t-shirt gift, etc.

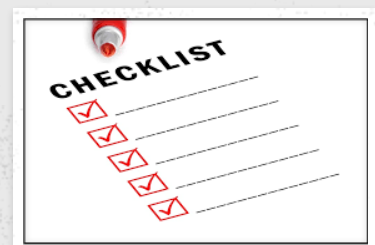
