### Fees Covered in Comprehensive Tuition\*\* (total fees are \$300 and wrapped into the charges above)

- Activity Fees: Local Field Trips (overnight/out-of-state trips not included), Celebration Shirts, PE Uniform, Yearbook, Graduation Fee
- **Technology Fees:** Technology Infrastructure, Wi-Fi access, Licensing, Chromebooks, iPads, Device Insurance
- Academic / Supply Fees: School Supply Materials, Bibles, Hymnals, Catechisms

## Tuition Payment Options – Payments made through TADS online management system

- Full Payment of Annual Tuition Payment made by July 15<sup>th</sup> preceding the academic year
- Semi-Annual Payment of Tuition Two payments made; one by July 15<sup>th</sup> preceding the academic year, one by Dec. 15<sup>th</sup> in the academic year
- Monthly Payment Plan Monthly payments made over 10 (July April) or 11 (July May) months.

## Multi-Child Discount

## EdChoice Scholarship Program
