With accessibility to the <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u>, an improved <u>District 23 website</u>, and continued, expanded communication tools, the following information will now be made available to families online:

Teacher Assignment Notification

- On August 14th all registered families should have received an email notification from Prospect Heights School District 23 (<u>Do Not Reply@d23.org</u>) that will contain information about a student's Homeroom or Advisory Teacher's Name.
- On August 16th at 9:00 a.m. it became possible to view a student's homeroom and schedule by logging into <u>PowerSchool Parent Portal</u> or by downloading the free PowerSchool Mobile App found on the App Store.

Curriculum Review

Dr. Amy Zaher, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction provided an overview of Curriculum materials, Professional Development goals, and Assessments to be implemented in the 2019-20 school year. The



primary focus for District 23 this year will be in the area of mathematics.

After a year long curriculum review, District 23 has adopted a new program to teach Math titled *Ready Mathematics*. *Ready Mathematics* helps address the emphasis on conceptual understanding through reasoning, modeling, and discussion that explore the structure of mathematics while also developing students' procedural fluency. Our teachers are excited to implement this new program. We are hoping that our students and parents are excited too!

Curriculum Associates' *Ready Mathematics* received a near-perfect rating by EdReports.org, an independent nonprofit that delivers evidence-based reviews of instructional materials.


