Students, teachers and parents across Illinois now have an opportunity to participate in the eighth annual statewide Illinois 5Essentials Survey. This survey is designed to generate a detailed picture of

the inner workings of your child's school. As a parent, this opportunity will allow you to share your thoughts on the important elements of school effectiveness in a survey about your child's school.

On behalf of the Illinois State Board of Education, the Illinois 5Essentials Survey will be administered online by UChicago Impact at the University of Chicago. The survey gathers data related to five indicators that can predict important student outcomes, including improved attendance and larger test score gains. These five indicators that affect and predict school success are:

- Effective Leaders
- Collaborative Teachers
- Involved Families
- Supportive Environments
- Ambitious Instruction

Your participation in the parent portion of the survey will help us understand the conditions at your child's school and guide improvement. Your identity and survey responses will be kept completely confidential and will never be connected to you or your child. The parent data will not be reported on the State Report Card.

#### District 23 Early Childhood Screening Information



School District 23 conducts monthly Early Childhood Screenings for children ages 3-5 who may qualify for preschool programming in the district. The purpose of the screening is to determine if your child qualifies for the at-risk preschool program as well as determine if there are any possible developmental delays. If developmental delays are noted, your child may be referred for further evaluation for special education services. If you are interested in

finding out more about the preschool program or are concerned about your child's development and would like more information about a screening, the evaluation process, or preschool special education services, please contact Eisenhower School at 847-870-3875. Please also share with your friends, family, and neighbors who live in School District 23 boundaries if you know they have children between the ages of 3-5. Thank you.
