You may want to check out the Teacher Wish List Display which can add new books to classroom library collections. Families may purchase books for children to present to teachers for this purpose. Stickers will be provided and placed in these books to recognize the donors.

We feel the book choice is a respectable collection and the majority range in price between \$5.00 and \$10.00. Be aware that pencils, and other trinkets will also be for sale as part of the Fair. You might want to consider providing special instructions to your children regarding purchases of these items.

Children will be allowed to shop during their library classes and at other times with approval from their teachers. Cash, checks (payable to Anne Sullivan School) and major credit cards will be accepted. Tax laws require us to charge sales tax (9.0%).
