- **Respectful Behavior:** We place significant value on respectful behavior throughout the games. This encompasses treating fellow attendees, players, coaches, officials, and staff with kindness and consideration. By fostering an atmosphere of mutual respect, we can all contribute to an enjoyable environment.
- **Cheering and Support:** We encourage students to show their support for our high school teams by cheering and clapping. Let's make our teams feel energized and appreciated! However, we kindly request that all attendees refrain from engaging in excessive or inappropriate behavior, such as negative comments or gestures. Such behavior may result in removal from an event.

Our middle school students should occupy the "middle school" section of the bleachers unless they are sitting with an adult. Likewise, elementary school students must be accompanied by a parent/guardian. Activities like running, climbing on fences, loitering in bathrooms, congregating around concessions, venturing onto the field, or other unsafe behaviors pose risks to everyone involved and may result in removal from an event.
- **Trash Disposal:** We kindly request that students use the provided trash bins to properly dispose of waste, helping us maintain a litter-free environment that everyone can enjoy.
- **Parental Supervision:** We deeply appreciate the role parents and guardians play in our events. It is essential and required that elementary-age students be accompanied by a responsible adult. Their presence and supervision contribute to the overall safety and enjoyment of all attendees.
- **Arrival and Departure:** Please be mindful of the game's timing to minimize any unsupervised periods.
