PBIS

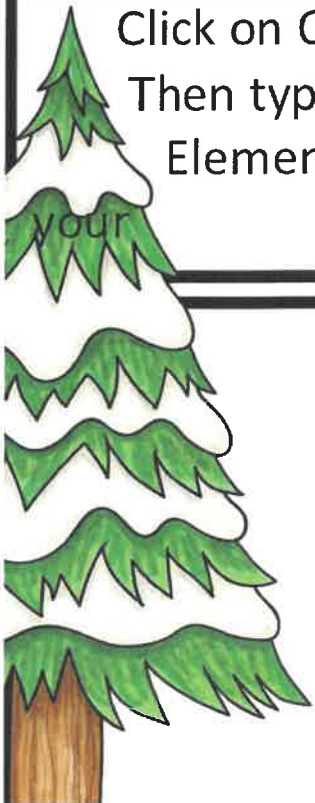
