Parents and Guardians,

We have had some questions regarding the Remote Day work packets that are assigned to students. Below are questions to questions that I have received.

1. **Do Remote Day Learning Assignments need to be completed?** Yes, these are to be completed and turned in.

Yes, there were things shared by our IMPACT teachers. These were just suggested activities for the students to do. We know that our students love their IMPACT classes and wanted to share some fun things they could do anytime, not just on Remote Learning Day.


2. **When are Remote Day Learning Assignments due?** They are due 5 days after they have been issued. For example, if we have a Remote Day on Thursday, December 9th then they would be due on Tuesday, December 14th.

We have had 4 Remote Days, Monday, January 26th through Thursday, January 29th. Since these were all consecutive days, all remote learning packets/assignments are due to be turned in on Tuesday, February 17th.

3. **Are Remote Day Learning Packets graded?** Yes, they are graded by the teachers.
4. **What if my child struggles with an assignment?** On Remote Learning days, teachers are available to assist the students. You can email the teacher, contact them on ClassDojo or message on Google Classroom(5th Grade). Your child can also ask for help with an assignment upon our return to school after a remote learning day.
