

## The short version of the Charlotte Valley Re-opening Plan

- 1. All NYDOH, CDC, NYSED and common sense protocols and guidelines ha and will be followed.
- 2. Face wearing, social distancing, and handwashing rules are in effect unfurther notice by order of the Governor.
- CVCS will open using the in-school model. Those will medical fragile
  conditions or reside with those with medically fragile conditions as outli
  by the DOH must obtain a Doctor's note and will be placed in our on-lin
  learning model until the Governor returns us to normal operating
  procedures.
- 4. In the case that COVID cases reach the 9% limit per 100,000 as cited by Governor and the DOH, The District will close and return to 100% remot learning.
- 5. Parents must screen their children every day with a temperature check signs of COVID before sending their child(ren) to school.
- 6. Students will be temperature checked every morning at their specific entrance. Those who fail will be reassessed by the school nurse in private
- Cleaning and sanitizing will occur in the classroom as students move fro class to class and at night as a matter of routine. All cleaning products meet DOH/CDC compliance.
- 8. Students must wash their hands after returning to the classroom.
- 9. Teachers, in the event of a full closure, will teach remotely from their classrooms.
- 10. All drills will occur as a matter of law.
- 11. All visitors will remain in the vestibule and only be allowed into the building by appointment. They will be subject to CVCS screening protoc
