Dear Parents and Guardians,

The beginning of the school year has been a whirlwind of activity. Due to our current environment, things are changing very quickly. We are doing our best to keep you up to date on all of the new developments as they unfold.

As we look at the COVID numbers locally and the opening of school, we have set some deadlines for our remote learners. We will be requiring remote learners without a bona fide medical note to return to in person school on Tuesday, **October 13, 2020**. Remember, your child as a remote learner is responsible for all work assigned and is required to attend in "real time" on their chrome books daily if they are in grades 4-12. Prek through 3rd grade are required to meet with Mrs. Leh during the scheduled times already communicated to the parent. Students with medical exemptions from in person learning are required to renew their specific medical documentation every five weeks unless a date is already noted on the previous note.

For all students, our Wednesday remote day will cease to exist as we move to a full in school model. In anticipation, it has been decided that we will continue to remain remote on September 23rd and September 30th. There is a Noon Dismissal on October 8th, a Superintendent's Conference Day scheduled for October 9th and there is also no school on October 12th due to Columbus Day. The first five day week of instruction falls on the week of October 19th.

Also, to ensure the safety of classmates, we are asking that you do not send in homemade snacks for classrooms. You may send in store bought individually packaged snacks only.

The weather is also beginning to change. Please make sure you send your student with appropriate clothing as we will be utilizing our outdoor spaces as much as possible and as long as possible. As always, if your student is sick please keep them home. Thank you for your support during these difficult times.
