Charlotte Valley Central School District voters approved the 13.3 million dollar capital improvement project referendum with a vote of 149-25 on December 6, 2022.

With this approval, the district will engage in capital improvement renovations that include the creation of a dedicated library media center, kitchen and cafeteria improvements, dedicated instrumental and choral spaces, a synthetic track and field surface, and energy efficiency upgrades.

Charlotte Valley CSD is expected to receive 80.8% state building aid on all eligible expenses. In addition, district voters approved the use of 2.0 million dollars from the capital reserve fund to offset tax levy liability.

The community's support of this project will provide students with high level facilities, while maximizing our current building's spaces for years to come. We look forward to the design, construction, and, of course, watching our students preparing in these spaces to conquer the challenges of tomorrow.
