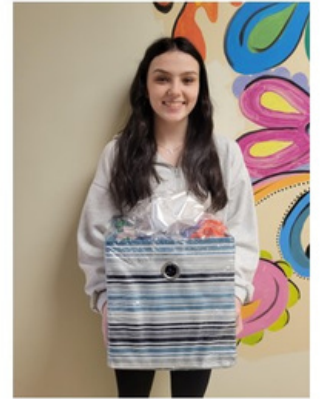
Benefits of learning about others in your school community

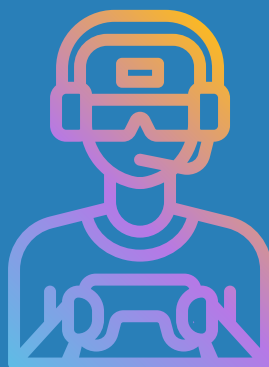

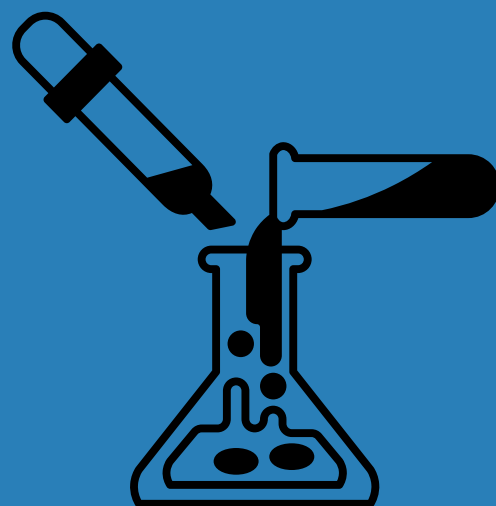
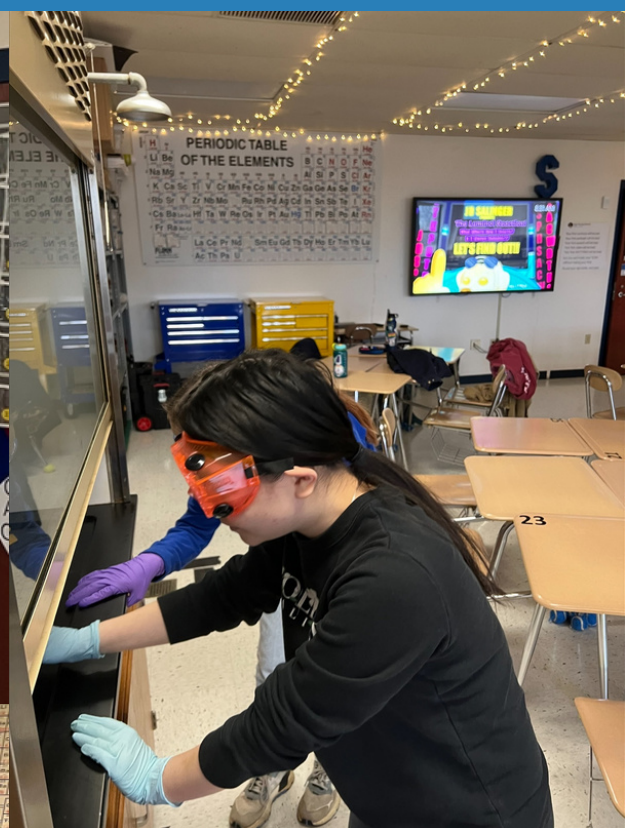
