Who Can Join 4-H?

4-H is open to ALL youth. Youth age 5 and in kindergarten until age 8 and in third grade participate in non-competitive activities and explore fun, hands-on interest areas. These members are called Cloverbuds.

Youth age 8 and in third grade through the year they turn 19 join as project members. These youth select one or more projects, ranging from archery and bicycling to swine, rabbits, food & nutrition, and veterinary science. Youth gain knowledge, explore project-related careers, and gain confidence as they work and learn together.

When Can I Join 4-H?

Pickaway County 4-H clubs start their year between November and January. Youth must be enrolled by **February 1** in order to participate in the current year's 4-H program and Fair.

Find a Club Near You!

There are 36 community-based 4-H Clubs in Pickaway County! Some clubs focus on a particular project area, such as horses, livestock or shooting sports while others are more general in nature.

Club members make their own decisions, participate in group activities and learning experiences, and get involved in community service projects. Clubs are led by screened and trained adult volunteers.
