At Union Local School District, the 4th nine weeks grading period begins on March 29, 2021. Recently the Ohio High School Athletic Association waived the academic requirements for the remainder of the school year. The Union Local School District will again be holding academic standards during the 4th nine weeks as outlined in the board approved athletic handbook. This means that for an athlete to be eligible in the fall for the 2021-2022 school year, each athlete must be passing a minimum of five classes.

For a student to be eligible for participation in athletics, a student enrolled in the first grading period after advancement from the eighth grade must have passed a minimum of five of all subjects carried the preceding grading period in which the student was enrolled. In order to be eligible in grades 9-12, a student must have received passing grades in a minimum of five (5) one-credit courses or the equivalent, each of which counts toward graduation.

A student in the 7th grade for the first time will be eligible for the first grading period regardless of the previous academic achievement. Thereafter, in order to be eligible, a student in grade 7 or 8 must be currently enrolled and must have been enrolled in school the immediately preceding grading period and received passing grades during that grading period in a minimum of five of those subjects in which the student received grades.

Please note that if a student's GPA falls below a 1.75 he/she must attend a study table intervention after school at least twice per week. If a student does not attend a study table, they must sit out the first game after the missed study table. This will go into effect during the 4th nine weeks grading period.
