Preschool Drop off/Pick up

Parents will enter from 716 on the north drive of the HS. Parents will stop at the stop sign, then turn at the weight room. Parents/drivers need to park and walk their child in or pick up their child from PK, they can park in the south/weight room parking lot. We ask that they park facing west so they can pull straight out and into the exiting car traffic (not back out of their parking spot), heading south. When leaving the parking lot, after dropping off/picking up, you will continue south and then turn left before entering the 'high school' parking lot. You will exit the campus onto 716. A stop sign will be added in the parking lot, as you leave campus when approaching the weight room, to allow for buses to have the right away

Morning traffic: School buses will arrive at the Elementary School and unload Elementary students (approximately 8:10-8:15). Buses will then continue to the high school to unload. For students being dropped off, students will not be permitted to go to their classroom until 8:10. Please do not plan to arrive/drop off your child before 8:10. When dropping off your child, please do so in a timely manner. Please be respectful to the other vehicles in line and to the safety of the students; wait in line and continue with the flow of traffic. Please avoid large gaps or passing vehicles who are dropping off. Drivers, as you leave the parking lot, please be alert and allow school buses to have the right away.

Afternoon traffic: K-8 Car riders will be dismissed at 3:12. Once vehicles are cleared, then the buses will be released. Drivers who are picking up please have your child(ren) load quickly into your vehicle. Please be respectful of the other vehicles in line and the safety of the students. Do not pass vehicles in front of you, stay in line, and avoid large gaps between vehicles. We understand that this may require your child(ren) to walk a little further, but we need to keep the safety of the children as our priority.

Tips that will help with arrival & dismissal:

- Safety is our number one priority
- Patience
- Consistent and routine means of arrival/dismissal - if your child rides the bus to/from school, keep that routine daily to avoid confusion
